Dear Parents/Carers,

During the first half term, **Swordfish (Year 5)** and **Oyster (Year 2)** will be taking part in beach sessions.

Dates:

- **Swordfish (Year 5):** Tuesday 8th September, 15th September and 6th October
 - **Oyster (Year 2):** Wednesday 9th September, 16th September and 7th October
- The sessions will give children the opportunity to learn outdoors, explore our local coastline and take part in practical activities linked to the environment and the area around them.

What should they wear?

Children can come to school in **non-school uniform** on their beach day. Please dress them according to the weather:

- **Warmer days:** comfortable shorts/trousers, long-sleeved top and light jacket.
- **Cooler/cold days:** joggers/trousers, jumper or fleece and a **waterproof jacket/coat**.
- Children can wear **trainers to school**, but please bring **wellies in a separate named bag** for the beach.
- A **spare pair of socks** is also recommended, just in case their socks get wet – **no one likes soggy socks!**

What if the weather is wet?

We aim to go ahead in **all weather conditions**, unless the weather becomes extremely unsuitable or unsafe. Please be prepared for your child to occasionally come home **damp, muddy or sandy** – it means they have had fun!

If they do come home wet, please get them changed into warm, dry clothes and give them a warm drink. **They will not be sitting in school wet and damp.** The children will return to school after 3pm and leave at the usual end of the school day.

We are looking forward to making the most of our fantastic local coastline and giving the children some exciting opportunities to learn outside!
